KEY COMPONENTS OF A HANDGUN

- BARREL: THE BARREL IS A METAL TUBE THROUGH WHICH THE BULLET TRAVELS WHEN FIRED. IT IS CRUCIAL FOR ACCURACY AND IS OFTEN RIFLED TO IMPROVE PROJECTILE STABILITY.
- **RECOIL SPRING:** THE RECOIL SPRING ABSORBS THE ENERGY FROM THE SLIDE'S MOVEMENT AND RETURNS IT TO ITS ORIGINAL POSITION, ALLOWING FOR A NEW ROUND TO BE CHAMBERED.
- TRIGGER: THE TRIGGER IS THE MECHANISM THAT, WHEN PULLED, RELEASES THE FIRING PIN TO STRIKE THE PRIMER OF THE CARTRIDGE.
- MAGAZINE: THE MAGAZINE STORES AMMUNITION AND FEEDS IT INTO THE CHAMBER AS NEEDED. IT CAN BE DETACHABLE OR INTEGRAL TO THE HANDGUN.
- SIGHTS: SIGHTS HELP THE SHOOTER AIM THE HANDGUN ACCURATELY, TYPICALLY CONSISTING OF A FRONT AND REAR SIGHT.

EACH OF THESE COMPONENTS IS ESSENTIAL FOR THE HANDGUN'S OPERATION, AND UNDERSTANDING THEIR FUNCTIONS IS CRUCIAL FOR ANYONE INVOLVED WITH FIREARMS.

Types of Handguns

A: Store your handgun in a secure, dry location, such as a gun safe or locked cabinet. It is also advisable to use a trigger lock or cable lock to enhance security and prevent unauthorized access.
