COMPONENTS OF THE SPINE

- COCCYGEAL VERTEBRAE (4, FUSED)
- **INTERVERTEBRAL DISCS:** THESE CARTILAGE STRUCTURES ACT AS SHOCK ABSORBERS BETWEEN VERTEBRAE, ALLOWING FOR FLEXIBILITY AND MOVEMENT.
- **LIGAMENTS:** LIGAMENTS CONNECT VERTEBRAE TO EACH OTHER, PROVIDING STABILITY AND SUPPORT TO THE SPINE.
- **SPINAL CORD:** ENCLOSED WITHIN THE VERTEBRAL COLUMN, THE SPINAL CORD IS A CRUCIAL PART OF THE CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM, TRANSMITTING SIGNALS BETWEEN THE BRAIN AND THE BODY.
- **NERVES:** SPINAL NERVES EMERGE FROM THE SPINAL CORD AND EXTEND TO VARIOUS PARTS OF THE BODY, FACILITATING COMMUNICATION WITHIN THE NERVOUS SYSTEM.
