The goal is to convince the investors. So you need to put yourself in the position of the investor and make sure that what you have written is done really, really well. The key to writing a good business plan is not only to have all the sections written such as Marketing plan, financial projection, and so on, but also to have answered all the questions that the investor might have for the project you're presenting. Always keep this in mind. I will remind you of this many times during this book as I am going to write the potential questions with italic font.
