The researcher also employed the use of online materials as part of its data collection. A stochastic frontier analysis was used to measure the satisfaction level of passengers on service quality, passengers profile and to evaluate the influence of service quality that the low cost air carrier provides to passengers. A general perspectives of the passengers satisfaction on low cost aircraft carriers' quality of service, affordability of airfare, on time departure and arrival was included to determine if satisfaction means excellent quality of service. the parameters passed the 2.5% and 1% level of significance. The significance of the parameters lead to rejection of the null hypothesis at 5% level of significance. the 5% level of significance was higher than the 2.5% and 1% level showing evidence of accepting the findings with confidence. Perceptions were separated into respondents (n = 297) that experienced boarding Philippine Airlines (PAL = 1, other airlines = 0) and Cebu Pacific (cebupacific = 1, others = 0) to detect passengers that were efficiently satisfied boarding the low cost aircraft carrier that was favored by the passengers.
