As such defenses of free enterprise are frequently criticized as "social Darwinism," however, this third and final installment of the trilogy asks the question, "What is social Darwinism?" The extent to which the popular narratives about social Darwinism prove to be inaccurate holds enormous ramifications for current controversies. It has implications for debates over the ethical appropriateness of reducing taxpayer spending on social welfare programs, and also sheds new light on the pros and cons of attempts to apply biological evolutionary theory to the study of human social institutions.
