The Commissions' recommendations follow a detailed consultation exercise - started with a discussion paper Insurance contract law (2007, LCCP 182/SLCDP 134, ISBN 9780117037823) - which found widespread support for the proposed changes from major insurers, insurance brokers and lawyers as well as consumer groups.
