Students aiming for college credit typically strived for scores of 3 or higher, though specific policies varied by institution.

Score reporting and timelines

Scores for the ap statistics international exam 2019 were released several weeks after the exam date, allowing time for grading and quality control. Candidates received their score reports electronically or by mail, depending on the arrangements with their testing centers.
