## UNDERSTANDING BOWEN FAMILY SYSTEMS THEORY

## PROMOTING DIFFERENTIATION OF SELF

DIFFERENTIATION OF SELF REFERS TO AN INDIVIDUAL'S ABILITY TO SEPARATE INTELLECTUAL AND EMOTIONAL FUNCTIONING, MAINTAINING AUTONOMY WHILE REMAINING EMOTIONALLY CONNECTED TO THE FAMILY. ## ADDRESSING EMOTIONAL TRIANGLES

EMOTIONAL TRIANGLES OCCUR WHEN TENSION BETWEEN TWO FAMILY MEMBERS PULLS IN A THIRD PARTY TO STABILIZE THE RELATIONSHIP. IDENTIFYING AND INTERVENING IN THESE TRIANGLES IS A CRITICAL BOWEN INTERVENTION. ## DETRIANGULATION TECHNIQUES

DETRIANGULATION IS THE PROCESS OF BREAKING THE EMOTIONAL TRIANGLES THAT CREATE CONFLICT AND ANXIETY.
