The district CHAMPS coordinator also led selected staff in site visits for other districts that had documented success through the use of CHAMPS. This study examined the implementation of CHAMPS, with a focus on STOIC components, at two high-need, inner-city elementary schools with high rates of office discipline referrals (ODRs). The study highlighted multiple areas which are in need of development to enhance the quality of implementation of CHAMPS. The study compared perceptions of teachers implementing the program as opposed to those who observed implementation in the classroom, school administrators, and behavior support staff. Based on the different times of implementation, this study compares perceptions from a school in year 1 implementation versus year 2

implementation. Gaps within the program were identified, and data did not support CHAMPS functioning effectively at either site.
