UNDERSTANDING THE STRUCTURE OF CONGRESS

THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS IS A BICAMERAL LEGISLATURE CONSISTING OF TWO CHAMBERS: THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. THE SENATE

THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

THE HOUSE HAS 435 VOTING MEMBERS DISTRIBUTED AMONG THE STATES BASED ON POPULATION, WITH EACH MEMBER SERVING A TWO-YEAR TERM. THIS CHAMBER IS DESIGNED TO REPRESENT THE POPULATION MORE DIRECTLY. THE HOUSE INITIATES REVENUE BILLS AND HAS THE SOLE POWER TO IMPEACH FEDERAL OFFICIALS.

CONGRESSIONAL LEADERSHIP

BOTH CHAMBERS HAVE LEADERSHIP POSITIONS THAT GUIDE LEGISLATIVE ACTIVITIES. THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE IS THE LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, WHILE THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES SERVES AS THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, CASTING TIE-BREAKING VOTES WHEN NECESSARY. MAJORITY AND MINORITY LEADERS AND WHIPS ASSIST IN MANAGING PARTY AGENDAS.

FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF CONGRESS

CONGRESS HOLDS SIGNIFICANT AUTHORITY UNDER THE U.S. CONSTITUTION, ENABLING IT TO LEGISLATE, OVERSEE THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, AND REPRESENT THE AMERICAN PEOPLE. KNOWING THESE FUNCTIONS IS FUNDAMENTAL TO ANSWERING CONGRESS KNOWLEDGE QUIZ ANSWERS ACCURATELY.

FLOOR DEBATE AND VOTING

IF A COMMITTEE APPROVES A BILL, IT MOVES TO THE FULL CHAMBER FOR DEBATE AND VOTING. MEMBERS DISCUSS THE BILL'S MERITS AND MAY PROPOSE FURTHER AMENDMENTS. A MAJORITY VOTE IS REQUIRED FOR THE BILL TO PASS.

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

IF THE HOUSE AND SENATE PASS DIFFERENT VERSIONS OF A BILL, A CONFERENCE COMMITTEE COMPOSED OF MEMBERS FROM BOTH CHAMBERS WORKS TO RECONCILE DIFFERENCES. THE FINAL VERSION MUST THEN BE APPROVED BY BOTH CHAMBERS.

PRESIDENTIAL APPROVAL

AFTER CONGRESS PASSES A BILL, IT IS SENT TO THE PRESIDENT, WHO CAN SIGN IT INTO LAW OR VETO IT. CONGRESS CAN OVERRIDE A VETO WITH A TWO-THIRDS MAJORITY IN BOTH CHAMBERS.
