UNDERSTANDING MASS CASUALTY INCIDENTS

MASS CASUALTY INCIDENTS (MCIS) INVOLVE EVENTS WHERE THE NUMBER OF INJURED OR AFFECTED INDIVIDUALS EXCEEDS THE IMMEDIATE TREATMENT CAPACITY OF HEALTHCARE FACILITIES. GOALS OF CODE ORANGE ACTIVATION

- EFFECTIVE TRIAGE AND TREATMENT OF INCOMING PATIENTS
- COORDINATION WITH EXTERNAL EMERGENCY SERVICES AND AGENCIES

- MAINTAINING COMMUNICATION LINES WITHIN THE HOSPITAL
- ENSURING PATIENT SAFETY AND CONTINUITY OF CARE

ACTIVATION PROCEDURES AND RESPONSE

THE ACTIVATION OF CODE ORANGE HOSPITAL AUSTRALIA FOLLOWS STRICT PROTOCOLS DESIGNED FOR SWIFT ACTION. THE PROCESS BEGINS WHEN AN INCIDENT IS REPORTED THAT HAS THE POTENTIAL TO OVERWHELM HOSPITAL CAPACITY. THIS MAY COME FROM EMERGENCY SERVICES, GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, OR INTERNAL HOSPITAL OBSERVATIONS.

INITIATING CODE ORANGE

ONCE ACTIVATED, A SERIES OF PREDEFINED PROCEDURES ARE INITIATED TO MANAGE THE CRISIS EFFECTIVELY. THESE PROCEDURES INCLUDE ALERTING STAFF, PREPARING EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS, AND REALLOCATING RESOURCES.

RESPONSE PHASES

THE RESPONSE TO A CODE ORANGE TYPICALLY INVOLVES SEVERAL KEY PHASES:

- 1. ALERT AND NOTIFICATION: IMMEDIATE COMMUNICATION TO HOSPITAL STAFF AND RELEVANT AGENCIES.

COMMUNICATION AND COORDINATION IN CODE ORANGE
