Dexter gave the network strong ratings, a new franchise, and a bankable star in Michael C. Hall. While the first season was strongly based off of Jeff Lindsay's novel *Darkly Dreaming Dexter*, producers decided to go a different route and branch away from the Lindsay books, creating their own storyline in the process for Season 2.
