The killers included strangers and neighbors, vigilantes and law enforcement officers—in particular, Texas Rangers. Despite a 1919 investigation of the state-sanctioned violence, no one in authority was ever held responsible. *Reverberations of Racial Violence* gathers fourteen essays on this dark chapter in American history.
