UNDERSTANDING SUBLIMINAL TAPES

TYPICALLY, SUBLIMINAL TAPES LAYER THESE HIDDEN MESSAGES BENEATH MUSIC, NATURE SOUNDS, OR WHITE NOISE TO MASK THEM FROM CONSCIOUS DETECTION WHILE ALLOWING THE SUBCONSCIOUS TO ABSORB THEM.

HISTORY OF SUBLIMINAL AUDIO

The notion of subliminal messaging dates back to the 1950s, when researchers discovered that visual and auditory stimuli below conscious awareness could affect choices and preferences. The first subliminal tapes appeared as a commercial product in the 1970s and 1980s, marketed as self-help tools for weight loss, smoking cessation, and confidence building.
