Kratos and Mimir complain that times were simpler then, and finding Tyr might have been a mistake on Atreus' part. Ignoring Freya's protests, Atreus and Cindriya sneak away to Midgard in an attempt to recruit Freya. Atreus first asks Jormungandr for advice on avoiding Ragnarok, and is disappointed that the only answer he gets is to go to Ironwood, which may not be a real place. Atreus meets Freya and reveals to her that he may be the last remaining giant, while Odin also briefly visits Midgard. Freya refuses to come and warns Atreus never to approach her again. On their way home, Cindri comforts Atreus and tells how Brock actually died and how Cindri partially revived him. Both promise to be more honest with Brok and Kratos in the end.

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
