HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF NORTH KOREAN EDUCATION

- **POLITICAL EDUCATION:** THIS SUBJECT IS PARAMOUNT, FOCUSING ON THE TEACHINGS OF KIM IL-SUNG, KIM JONG-IL, AND KIM JONG-UN, ENSURING THAT STUDENTS DEVELOP A STRONG IDEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION.

SPECIALIZED EDUCATION

IN ADDITION TO CORE SUBJECTS, NORTH KOREAN TEXTBOOKS ALSO DELVE INTO SPECIALIZED EDUCATION, WHICH INCLUDES:

- **TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING:** TEXTBOOKS USED IN THESE AREAS EMPHASIZE SKILLS THAT SUPPORT THE STATE'S INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL GOALS.

THE ROLE OF TEXTBOOKS IN PROPAGANDA

THE PORTRAYAL OF EXTERNAL ENEMIES, PARTICULARLY THE UNITED STATES AND SOUTH KOREA, IS ALSO PREVALENT, FOSTERING A SENSE OF NATIONALISM AND UNITY AGAINST PERCEIVED THREATS.

CHALLENGES AND CRITIQUES OF NORTH KOREAN TEXTBOOKS

WHILE NORTH KOREAN TEXTBOOKS SERVE THE REGIME'S PURPOSES, THEY FACE SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES AND CRITIQUES. ONE OF THE PRIMARY CRITICISMS IS THEIR LACK OF SCIENTIFIC RIGOR AND FACTUAL ACCURACY, PARTICULARLY IN SUBJECTS LIKE HISTORY AND SCIENCE.

FURTHERMORE, THE HEAVY IDEOLOGICAL SLANT LIMITS STUDENTS' ABILITY TO ENGAGE WITH DIVERSE VIEWPOINTS OR DEVELOP CRITICAL THINKING SKILLS. THIS EDUCATIONAL APPROACH HAS LONG-TERM IMPLICATIONS FOR NORTH KOREAN SOCIETY, POTENTIALLY STUNTING TECHNOLOGICAL AND INTELLECTUAL GROWTH.

THE FUTURE OF EDUCATION AND TEXTBOOKS IN NORTH KOREA

AS NORTH KOREA CONTINUES TO FACE GLOBAL SCRUTINY AND ECONOMIC CHALLENGES, THE FUTURE OF ITS EDUCATION SYSTEM AND TEXTBOOKS REMAINS UNCERTAIN. CONCLUSION

north korean textbooks: *The Real North Korea* Andrei Lankov, 2013-04-10 Andrei Lankov has gone where few outsiders have ever been. A native of the former Soviet Union, he lived as an exchange student in North Korea in the 1980s. He has studied it for his entire career, using his fluency in Korean and personal contacts to build a rich, nuanced understanding. In *The Real North Korea*, Lankov substitutes cold, clear analysis for the overheated rhetoric surrounding this opaque police state. After providing an accessible history of the nation, he turns his focus to what North Korea is, what its leadership thinks, and how its people cope with living in such an oppressive and poor place. He argues that North Korea is not irrational, and nothing shows this better than its continuing survival against all odds. A living political fossil, it clings to existence in the face of limited resources and a zombie economy, manipulating great powers despite its weakness. Its leaders are not ideological zealots or madmen, but perhaps the best practitioners of Machiavellian politics that can be found in the modern world. Even though they preside over a failed state, they have successfully used diplomacy-including nuclear threats-to extract support from other nations. But while the people in charge have been ruthless and successful in holding on to power, Lankov goes on to argue that this cannot continue forever, since the old system is slowly falling apart. In the long run, with or without reform, the regime is unsustainable. Lankov contends that reforms, if attempted, will trigger a dramatic implosion of the regime. They will not prolong its existence. Based on vast expertise, this book reveals how average North Koreans live, how their leaders rule, and how both survive.

north korean textbooks: What Shall We Tell the Children? Stuart J. Foster, Keith A. Crawford, 2006-04-01 The pages of this book illustrate that as instruments of socialization and sites of ideological discourse textbooks are powerful artefacts in introducing young people to a specific historical, cultural and socioeconomic order. Crucially, exploring the social construction of school textbooks and the messages they impart provides an important context from within which to critically investigate the dynamics underlying the cultural politics of education and the social movements that form it and which are formed by it. The school curriculum is essentially the knowledge system of a society incorporating its values and its dominant ideology. The curriculum is not "our knowledge" born of a broad hegemonic consensus, rather it is a battleground in which cultural authority and the right to define what is labelled legitimate knowledge is fought over. As each chapter in this book illustrates curriculum as theory and practice has never been, and can never be, divorced from the ethical, economic, political, and cultural conflicts of society which impact so deeply upon it. We cannot escape the clear implication that questions about what knowledge is of most worth and about how it should be organized and taught are problematic, contentious and very serious.

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such an introspective effort has the potential to lay the foundation for greater self- and mutual understanding and eventual historical reconciliation in the region. This book will be essential reading for students and scholars of Asian history, Asian education and international relations in East Asia.

north korean textbooks: *Historical Development of English Learning Motivation Research* Tae-Young Kim, 2021-09-07 This book clarifies the fundamental difference between North America-based instrumental motivation and Korea (and East Asia)-specific competitive motivation by which the EFL learners' excessive competition to be admitted to famous universities and to be hired at a large-scale conglomerate is the main source of L2 motivation. It enables readers to understand that EFL-learning motivation reflects unique sociohistorical contexts grounded in a specific region or country. This book in turn necessitates the need to develop EFL motivation theory and research tradition which are firmly based on East Asian values and culture.

north korean textbooks: *Korea Naval War College (U.S.). Asia-Pacific Studies Group. Asia-Pacific Forum*, 2006 This book is a collection of 16 essays by international authors who participated in an academic conference on Korea sponsored by the U.S. Naval War College. north korean textbooks: *Multicultural Education in South Korea* Mi Ok Kang, 2014-11-13 This book examines the political, ideological, and socio-cultural politics underlying the 2009 National Multicultural Curriculum Reform and recent multicultural education policies in South Korea. Unlike the conservative groups in Western countries who argue that supporting cultural diversity and the cultural rights of minority groups balkanizes ethnic differences and divides the community, the New Rights and the conservative groups in South Korea have been very supportive of multicultural discourses and practices and have created many multicultural policy agendas geared toward ushering in what have they called the multicultural era. multicultural knowledge control in education and society; Formation of discourses on multicultural society and multicultural education; Examining the national curriculum: The politics of representing migrant Others; and The hidden curriculum of multicultural education: Limitations and possibilities. The author's insightful discussion on the politics of knowledge, education, and teaching in multicultural societies will prove particularly useful to policy makers, think-tank officials, and academic scholars in education.

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north korean textbooks: *De-Bordering Korea* Valérie Gelézeau, Koen De Ceuster, Alain Delissen, 2013-05-02 As tensions remain on the Korean peninsula, this book looks back on the decade of improved inter-Korean relations and engagement between 1998 and 2008, now known as the 'Sunshine Policy' era. Moving beyond traditional economic and political perspectives, it explores how this decade of intensified cooperation both affected and reshaped existing physical, social and mental boundaries between the two Koreas, and how this 'de-bordering' and 're-bordering' has changed the respective attitudes towards the other. In fact, Korean people should realize that during the 1900's, Japan helped Korea economically and socially, and improved Korea's social and physical infrastructure that laid the foundation for Korea to become a modernized and industrialized society. Japan also has been fulfilling Korea's requests, such as paying compensatory money for "so-called comfort women." However, it seems that such compensation was not enough to Korean people, who kept asking for more. We cannot deny the fact that Korea has been taking an advantage of the comfort woman issue and the kind-hearted attitude of the Japanese people. As a result, Korean people keep on looking down Japanese people and spreading Korean people's hate toward Japanese people through Korea's education system.
