GAO also reviewed websites of a nationally representative sample of schools, complaint data from Education, and relevant federal laws.

Feldman, 2010-11-10 Much of what is written about colleges and universities ties rapidly rising tuition to dysfunctional behavior in the academy. Common targets of dysfunction include prestige games among universities, gold plated amenities, and bloated administration. This book offers a different view. To explain rising college cost, the authors place the higher education industry firmly within the larger economic history of the United States. The trajectory of college cost is similar to cost behavior in many other industries, and this is no coincidence. Higher education is a personal service that relies on highly educated labor. A technological trio of broad economic forces has come together in the last thirty years to cause higher education costs, and costs in many other industries, to rise much more rapidly than the inflation rate. The main culprit is economic growth itself. This finding does not mean that all is well in American higher education. A college education has become less reachable to a broad swathe of the American public at the same time that the market demand for highly educated people has soared. This affordability problem has deep roots. The authors explore how cost pressure, the changing wage structure of the US economy, and the complexity of financial aid policy combine to reduce access to higher education below what we need in the 21st century labor market. This book is a call to calm the rhetoric of blame and to instead find policies that will increase access to higher education while preserving the quality of our colleges and

universities.

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the cost of college textbooks: College Textbooks General Accounting Office, Washington, DC., 2005 In academic year 2003-2004, students and their families spent over \$6 billion on new and used textbooks. Given that nearly half of undergraduates receive federal financial aid and that the cost of textbooks is one component considered in making these awards, escalating textbook prices can impact federal spending. Because of the impact on access, affordability, and federal spending, recent reports of escalating textbook prices and instances in which publishers sell U.S. textbooks in other countries at lower prices have heightened congressional concern and raised questions about textbook pricing practices. Congress has asked the GAO to determine: (1) What has been the increase, if any, in textbook prices? (2) What factors have contributed to changes in textbook prices? and (3) what factors explain why a given U.S. textbook may retail outside the United States for a different price? Using data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics and the Department of Education's Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), it was determined that college textbook prices have risen at twice the rate of annual inflation over the last two decades, mostly as a result of the increase in costs associated with new features and of more frequent revisions. Differences in pricing between the United States and other locations may occur because publishers price their textbooks in order to compete in local markets, and because the cost of printing additional copies of a textbook produced for the U.S. market for sale elsewhere is relatively low.
